More than 1,000 buyers and 1260 exhibitors from 25 African countries signed up for this year's Africa's Travel Indaba, hosted by South African Tourism (SAT). The event returned to the Albert Luthuli Convention Centre (ICC) in Durban in May. Themed 'Unlimited Africa', this year's programme featured extra networking opportunities and even more impactful engagement sessions.

Organisers said at least 24,000 meetings took place, and the show contributed around R500 million to Durban's economy and created more than 1.000 iobs.

AirlinePros South Africa was at Durban's ICC to support two partner airlines, Eswatini Air and Uganda Airlines.

Nombulelo Guliwe, Chief Executive Officer at SAT, said: "We continue to pride ourselves on delivering the best of the African continent's tourism products and experiences, and this year, we cemented this position with an increase of 9% in the number of African countries participating in this trade show. This is all thanks to all our partners. The significant increase reflects the robust growth of the African tourism sector."
